**March 15, 2017 – Arrival** 

Day 1 (March 16, 2017)

The representatives from the all regional partners participated in the meeting. Raziya Isayeva, Development Director welcomed all participants and gave the floor to Dr. Hassan Niknafs, rector of the Khazar University. He also welcomed all participants and spoke about the importance of the AESOP project. Speeches also were made by Prof. George Gavtadze, rector of Akaki Tsereteli State University, Prof Kakha Shengelia, rector of Caucasus University, Yashar Omarov, Senior Advisor of Ministry of Education of Azerbaijan and Parviz Bagirov, head of National Erasmus + Office in Azerbaijan.

After the welcome speeches, nine regional partner universities made presentations on the results of the needs assessment survey, which conducted among their universities staff and students. Afterwards the presentations, all partners discussed the acquired results and the challenges during conducting the survey.

#### Day 2 (March 17, 2017)

The second day of the meeting started with the reviewing of the results of previous day. All regional partners prepared the plan for EU university visit and came to consensus on what areas should be focused on in observing EU practices in student advocacy. The following issues are decided to observe during the visits:

- 1. Guidelines on students' rights and responsibilities;
- 2. Guidelines on administrative and academic staff rights and responsibilities;
- 3. General legislation on student advocacy;
- 4. Any changes in internal policy caused by establishing Ombuds office;
- 5. Obligations and responsibilities of the Ombuds office;
- 6. Duties and responsibilities of Ombudsperson;
- 7. Who should be chosen as a Ombuds person (characteristics, position, education, any particular skills):
- 8. How many employees should be at the Ombuds office;
- 9. Issues of naming the persons who apply with complaints and problems. Is it anonymous process or not? In which case yes or no;
- 10. Distinction of Students Union/ Self Government from the Ombuds Office;
- 11. Evaluation of effectiveness of the Office activities. (tools, merit);
- 12. Evaluation and monitoring of the results of solved issues;
- 13. Students involvement in Evaluation process;
- 14. Providing the regional partners with several case studies related to the activities of the Ombuds office;
- 15. Explaining the procedures from the beginning and to the end;
- 16. Explaining the procedures and mechanism of problem solving;
- 17. Sharing the challenges faced by EU partners when they started to establish Ombuds office;
- 18. The scope of involvement of Administration. Relationship, procedures and mechanism of working with Administration;
- 19. At what scope the university administration can affect the function of the office;
- 20. Do EU partners conduct any trainings for academic and administrative staff and students? If yes, could they share with us them?
- 21. Any kind of technological supports they possess;
- 22. How do Ombuds office fund itself?

During the meeting, the financial issues were discussed as well.

At the end of the meeting, all regional partners visited the Palace of the Shirvanshahs. The students of Khazar University guided regional partners through the Old City (İçəri Şəhər) and gave detailed information about its history.
